

# Tenino Monthly Sewer Update

February 2, 2009

## Sewer Plant (WWTP)

Boss Construction is progressing with the WWTP. The first week of January they poured the basin slab followed by the first wall pour during the third full week of January. They are currently set to pour the 2<sup>nd</sup> of four wall pours the first week of February. Excavation is under way for the ponds and the permanent driveway entrance base is almost completed.

## Right of Way Construction (ROW)

Work continues with the Right of Way and Landis and Landis is still expecting completion of the force mains by the first of April. Thanks to the warmer dry weather later in January, substantial asphalt patching was accomplished on our streets.

## Service Connection (Grinder pump install and connection to Houses)

The contract with RP and Company for the grinder pumps has been executed and Notice to Proceed was issued for February 17, 2009. We held the pre-construction meeting last week with discussions on how they would proceed with the installations. RP & Co. will provide a detailed schedule to the City of Tenino prior to beginning construction. **With the execution of this contract, changing from/to shared grinder pumps is no longer an option for the citizens of Tenino. What is on the latest plans is what will be installed.**

During the upcoming weeks, city staff and representatives from RP & Co will be hanging notifications on doors in advance of upcoming work on homeowner's property. Prior to the actual excavation, representatives will be digging inspection holes to locate sewer line depths at each house as well as photographing each individual lot to document existing conditions prior to starting the excavation work. We currently do not have a schedule or sequence for this work so please look for the door hangers for notification of upcoming work.

With the installation of the grinder pumps about to begin, homeowners are reminded of their responsibility to make the electrical connection from the City's control panel to your electrical breaker panel. For questions concerning this connection please call Ron Kemp @ city hall.
