As we begin a New Year, it is a time of reflection and setting goals for 2009. Your Planning Commission was very busy in 2008 and will continue facing decisions that will impact the future of Tenino for years to come.

Major accomplishments of the Planning Commission in 2008 include:

In 2008 the Planning Commission completed the design standards and traffic survey's started in 2007. The results were sent out in the water bill in late summer.

We held a series of work sessions and meetings where we reviewed and analyzed the current land uses allowed in the city code. During these meetings we solicited citizen involvement and comments. At the completion of these sessions we issued a guidance document that outlined the Planning Commission's ideas for what the future development of the Westside annexation may look like.

After a busy 2008, the Planning Commission is looking forward to the work ahead and in 2009 we will continue working on the goal of the Planning Commission to provide for growth, which reflects the broad interest of the community, by supplying informed recommendations to the City Council. In the up-coming year, we will be working on an update to the capital facilities plan, design standards, traffic impacts and other pressing issues as they emerge. We need the citizen's help in developing and presenting informed decisions for the future. We encourage the residents of Tenino to become active in the future of our community. Planning Commission meetings are held the second and third Thursday of each month at 7:00 PM at City Hall.
